

An important update for Members, Guests and Visitors of The Hills Club

Dear Members and Guests,

All bar, bistro and other services will be functioning as usual in line with imposed government restrictions. We have continued to implement measures to ensure we are doing all we can to create the safest environment possible, along with complying with rather challenging operating requirements directed by the government bodies. We will continue adapt to the situation as best we can.

A few things we have done to date include increase hygiene practices and supplying of sanitising units throughout the club. We have also taken measure with food handling procedures including using packaged cutlery for food service. We have implemented signage relating to social distancing to remind patrons of the requirement to practice this when in the club. We have removed much of the club's furniture to assist with this and created distancing measures through this as much as practicable.

I would please ask that all patrons do their best to cooperate with and staff requests or directives in relation to the social distancing issue. It is very important that we maintain the correct numbers in each designated space to comply and as such we will be conducting head counts and monitoring this carefully. Please follow any directions from staff courteously.

- All association and club bowls (rollups and barefoot bowls will be permitted under guidelines complying with government directives)

We will be running the courtesy bus this weekend under strict measures (ie. Limited numbers) with regular cleaning throughout the shift. We will at this point suspend the courtesy bus as of Monday the 23rd of March, 2020.
